



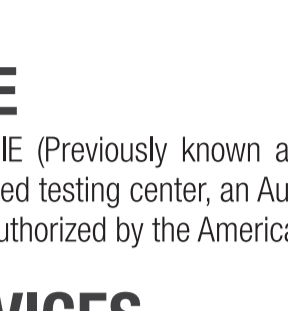

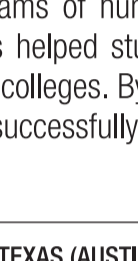

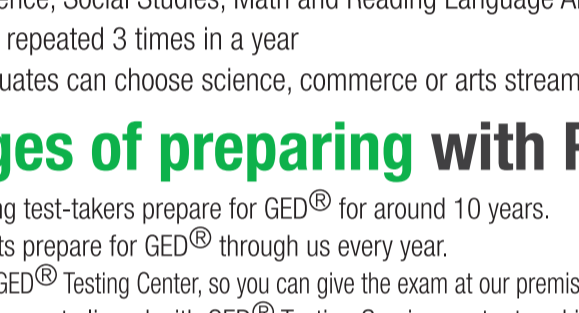

What is the GED® test?

The GED® test is a High School (12th grade) equivalency test based in the United States, and delivered in Canada and in 60 additional countries. Passing the GED® test, grants the test-taker a U.S High School Diploma credential. More than 20 million people have passed the GED® test since 1942.

Test-takers preferring to go abroad for higher studies take the GED® to save valuable time and money. 97% of US colleges and Universities accept GED®.

Test-takers can also study in local universities as GED® is approved by University Grants Commission Bangladesh and most local universities recognize the GED® as well.

The GED® test is for you if you:

- Are 16 years of age and over.
- Have financial restrictions to complete high school but want to study in university.
- Have a study gap and can't get into university.
- Want to get into a profession that has a minimum 12 years of schooling requirement.

SAT

The SAT is a globally recognized college admission test that tests students' knowledge of reading, writing and basic mathematics up to high school level. The SAT examinations are held 6-7 times a year and has a total score of 1600.

Students take SAT to seek admission in colleges and universities in USA and most importantly to secure scholarships in such universities. Also, local universities have their entrance examination format similar to SAT and thus if you have a high SAT score, you often don't have to sit for a local university's entrance exam!

TOEFL vs. IELTS

Which exam should you take?

Many international institutes accept both TOEFL and IELTS as a proof of English proficiency but TOEFL certification is generally demanded by North American institutes and IELTS for institutes in UK, Australia, New Zealand, Ireland, South Africa and a few other countries. IELTS is also taken by people looking to migrate to such countries.
